




INDEPENDANCE DAY 2024

GUEST LECTURE SERIES



ANTI-DRUG AWARENESS DAY




WORLD POPULATION DAY OBSERVATION




WORLD HEPATITIS DAY

OBSERVATIONAL VISIT




ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS


ALUMMNI MEET




