PARTICIPATORY MODULE BASED WORKSHOP



Dept. of Child Health Nursing and IQAC PCON organized state level two day participatory module based workshop of ENBC & FBNC modules on topic 'Essential Newborn Nursing' on 21st and 22nd February 2024 from 8am to 4.30pm at the College auditorium. The purpose of the workshop was to help participants gain the cognitive & psychomotor skills necessary for ensuring health survival of neonate's. The resource persons were Dr. Jacob Abraham, Prof. & HOD, Dept. of Pediatrics, PIMS & RC and the faculty of Pushpagiri College of Nursing, along with Dr. Jacob his assistance Dr. Angela George, Dr. Bincy Philip & Dr. Bincy Varghese participated. Mrs. Shibi Mariam Thomas, Associate Professor & HOD, Dept. of Nursing Foundations; Mrs. Roshin Siby (Assistant Professor), Mrs. Neethu Devan (Lecturer) & Mrs. Jyothi Vishnu Thampi, (Tutor), Department of Child Health Nursing also led classes. The workshop covered various topics namely- Basic needs, at birth as well as routine care & monitoring of the newborn; Thermoregulation, Kangaroo mother care, Feeding, Infection prevention, common newborn nursing procedures, care of at risk & sick neonates and Neonatal resuscitation. Following the main sessions, vote of thanks was proposed by Mrs. Roshin Siby. Prof. Mrs. Vineetha Jacob handed over the token of appreciation to the resource persons. IMNCI WORKSHOP

A State level Workshop was a two day participatory module based workshop of IMNCI Guidelines and Updates "organized by the IQAC and Dept. of Child Health Nursing, Pushpagiri College of Nursing on 21st and 22nd march 2024 from 8am to 4.00pm at the College Auditorium. The workshop was designed to help nursing students in developing knowledge and competencies required for assessment, diagnosis, treatment, nursing care of infants and children with various diseases using guidelines as per IMNCI in the hospital and home settings. It involved Lectures, Group Discussions, Role play, Video Demonstrations and Case Study Discussions of various aspects of IMNCI Case Management Process. The main resource person was Dr. D. Balachandar, IMNCI trainer & Senior Consultant Pediatrician, General Hospital Pathanamthitta. Also, faculty from Child Health Nursing took classes. The workshop covered various aspects of IMNCI including- Introduction to IMNCI (Dr. Balachandran), OP management of young infant – (small group sessions by all faculty), Counseling, Follow-up & practices to support child development - (Prof. Sr. Mary Jyothi) OP management of sick children (small group sessions by all faculty), Feeding & Developmental supportive care for sick children (Mrs. Roshin Siby), Treatment of sick children (Mrs. Neethu Devan) and some case study discussions. Nearly 100 participants participated the same.

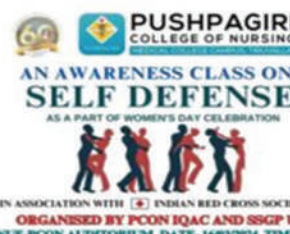
OBSERVANCE OF WORLD LEPROSY DAY
